General English

5 – 45 weeks

- Develop your reading, writing, speaking and listening skills.
- Build your confidence by increasing your fluency and accuracy.
- Take a class placement test on the first day to find the right class level.
- Elementary to advanced levels available.
- Participate in cultural studies, including trips and activities.

English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

10 or 15 weeks

- Build your confidence in speaking, presentations, digital research, academic writing and note taking.
- Improve your language proficiency before commencing your Study Abroad semester or year.

Study Abroad with diploma units

1 semester or 1 year

- Develop your language skills while studying diploma-level units.
- Diploma units available in business, creative industries, IT, health, science and engineering.
- Study with other international students at QUT College, with access to all QUT facilities.

Requirements

You must:

- study a minimum of one communication unit with the diploma subjects
- complete senior high school Maths B for engineering subjects
- study the standard diploma program to graduate with a QUT Diploma.

Study Abroad with communication units

1 semester or 1 year

- Develop your English skills and experience university at a degree level.
- Study two English communication units at QUT College plus one or two degree units from your chosen faculty.
