**Postgraduate:** successful completion of a bachelor's degree or equivalent from a recognised higher education institution.

- A block is a 4-week intensive subject offering that can be completed pre or post or concurrent to the trimester.

A student may wish to utilise a block to extend their study abroad or exchange and to lighten their subject load. For example, a student could take three subjects for 9 credits in Trimester 1 and then add on a block for an additional 3 credits, rather than taking four subjects (12 credits) in a single trimester.

### **Application Information**

Nomination process – required for Exchange students ONLY

Nominations for Exchange can be submitted at any point up until the relevant nomination deadline via our online **JCU Exchange Program Nomination Form**.

Our team will contact both the student and the home institution via email to advise whether the nomination has been accepted. Approved nominees can then submit an application.

#### **Application process**



The Study Abroad and Exchange Application Form can be downloaded **here**.

**Exchange students** must wait to be advised of the outcome of their nomination prior to submitting an application via their home institution.

**Study Abroad students** should proceed straight to the application stage (no nomination required) and can apply directly to <a href="mailto:internationaladmissions@jcu.edu.au">internationaladmissions@jcu.edu.au</a> or via a registered agent.

Successful applicants will receive an Offer Letter via email. Once the offer acceptance and payment have been processed, an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE) will be issued.

Documents required for application

- Completed Study Abroad and Exchange Application Form
- Previous and current certified academic transcripts\* and certificates (if completed) and the Grading Scale
  used at the institution/s studied at. Include certified English translations if transcripts are not in English.
- Proof of English proficiency\* (not required for native English speakers)
- A copy of the biodata page of the passport

#### **Fees and Costs**

JCU tuition fees are payable only by Study Abroad students. Exchange students continue to pay tuition fees as usual to their home institution. All fees indicated below are in Australian dollars.

#### Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)
